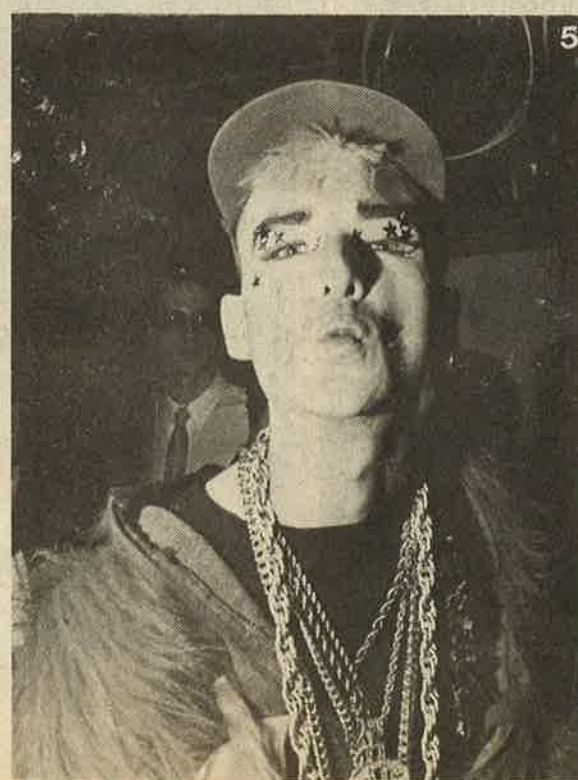

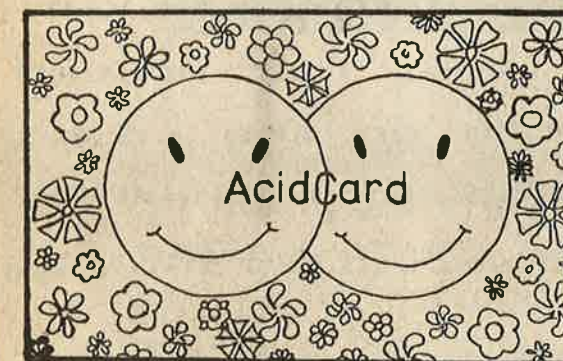

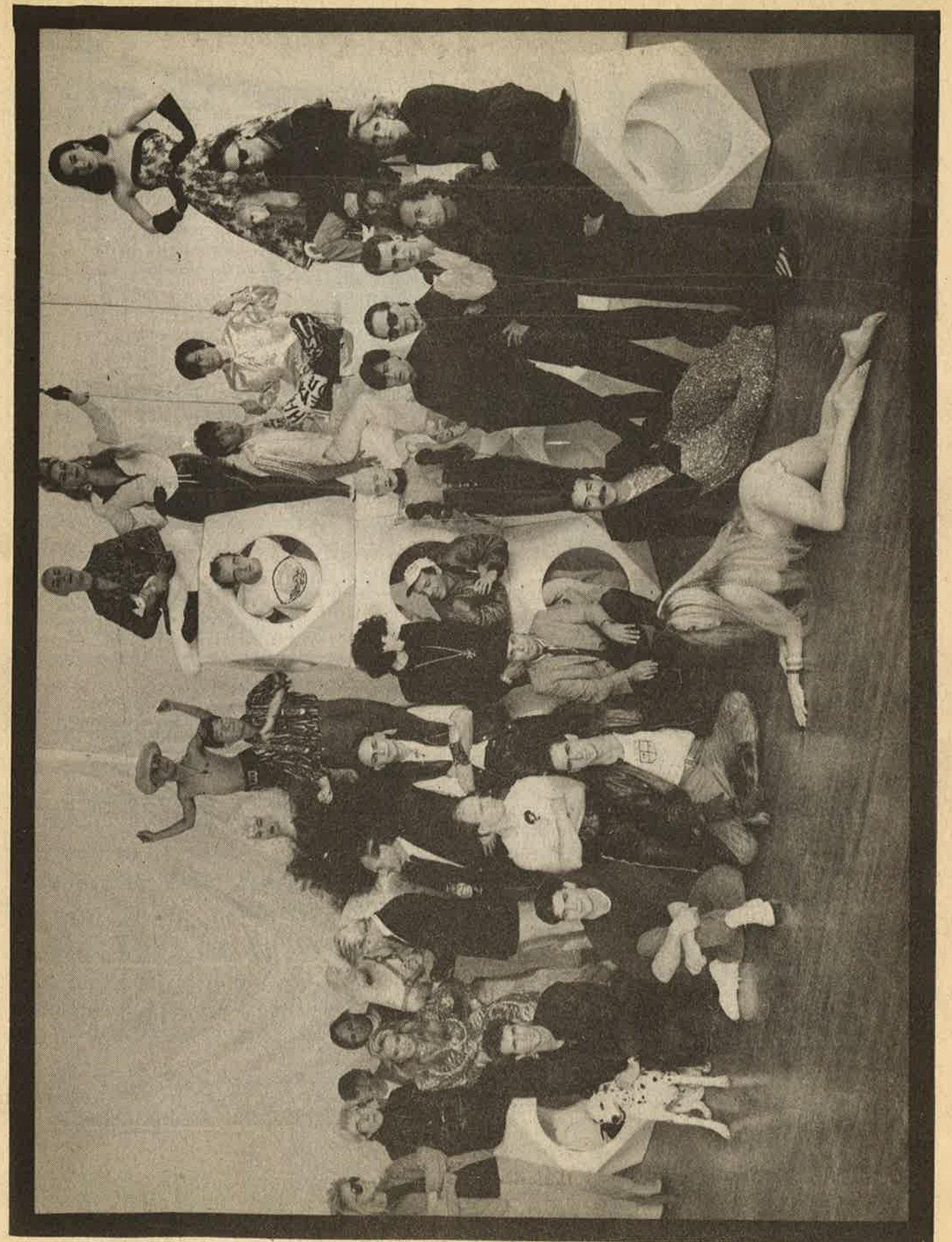
Younger, hipper, but maybe not quite as motivated, we were friendlier and flashier than our predecessors - even if we didn't get quite as far or garnered as much press.

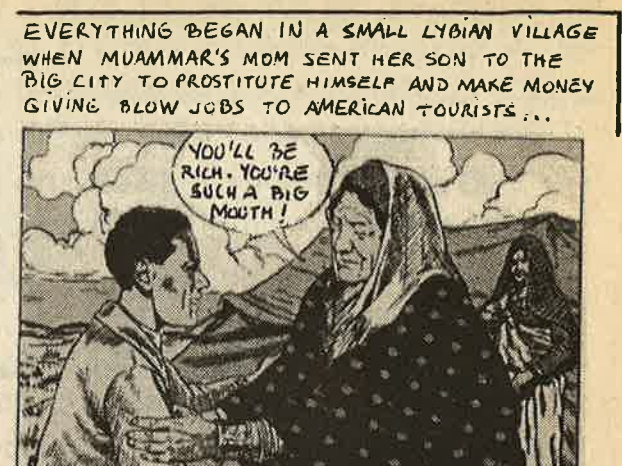

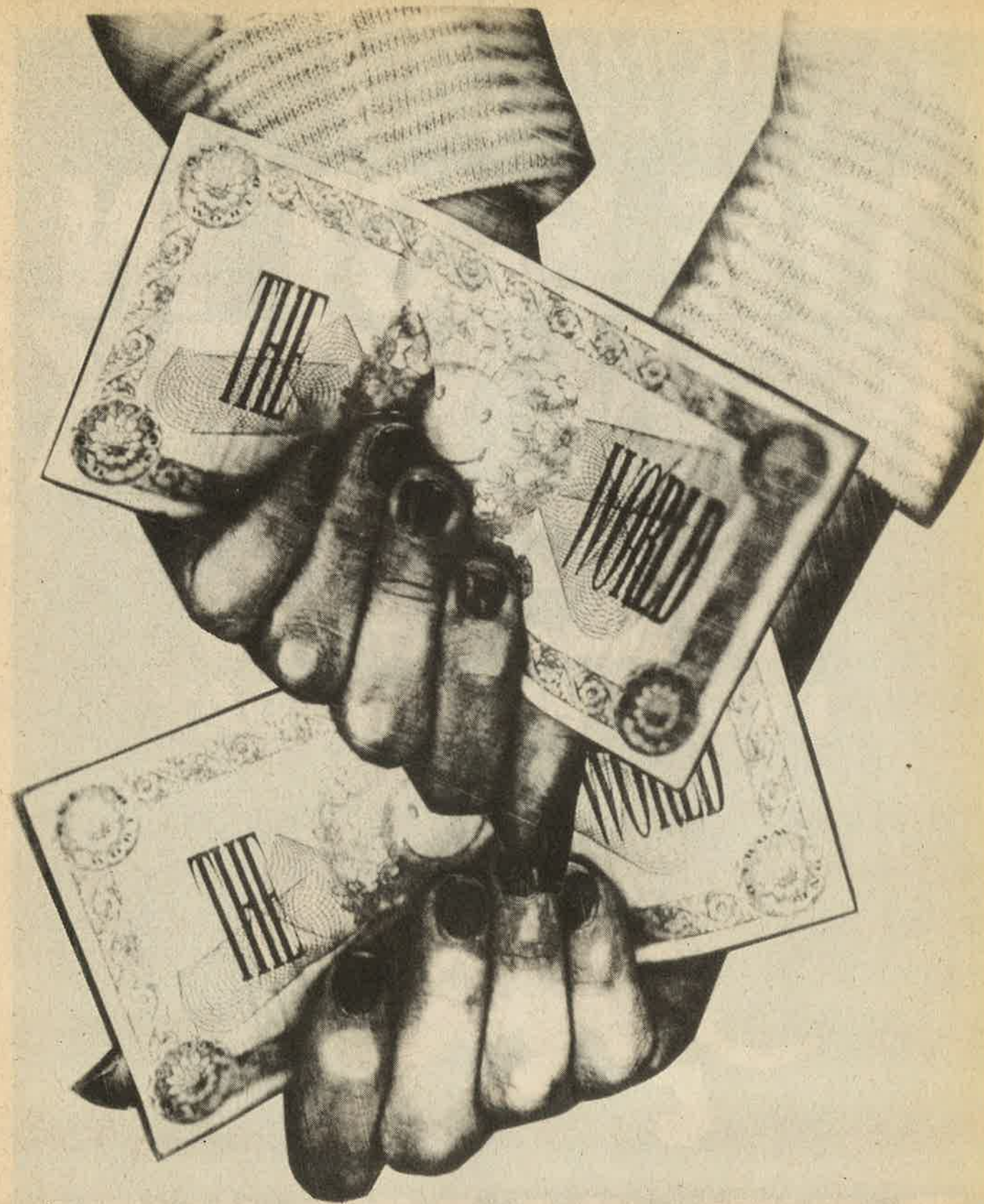
